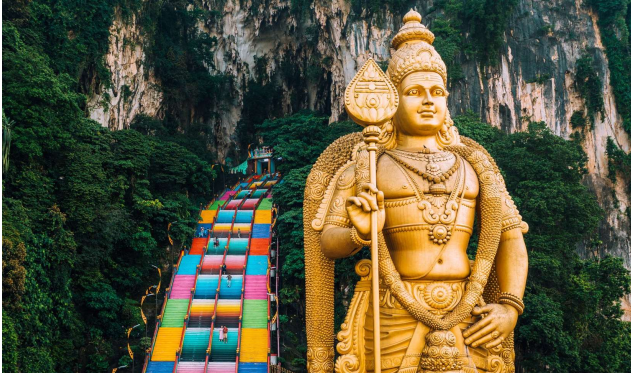


## Day 2 (27<sup>th</sup> Apr) | Colombo → Kuala Lumpur (Malaysia)

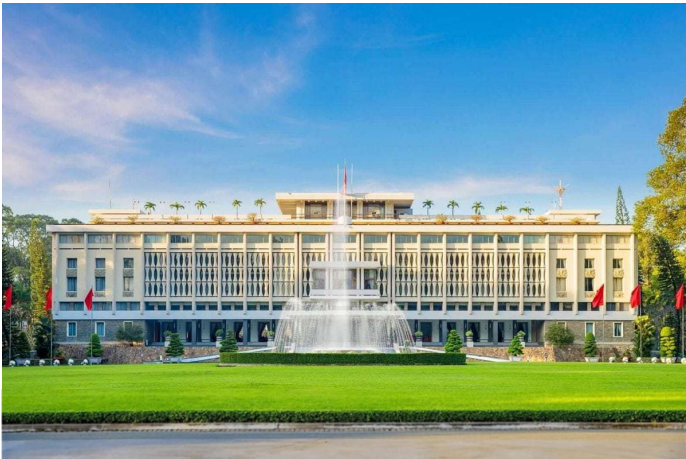
